



## **PARK PERMIT RULES & REGULATIONS**

This outline of Ordinance 79 and Ordinance 525 is provided for your information. A complete copy of both ordinances is available upon request.

The following areas are controlled, violators subject to fines.

- 1) All groups using the Parks must secure a Park Permit in advance of the outing. A group representative must have in their possession the Permit during the time of the event.
- 2) Alcohol is not allowed in the Parks. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or other chemical abuse substances is not allowed in the Park.
- 3) Open fires are not allowed. Grilling and/or cooking of food must be done in a kettle grill. Used charcoal must be taken with you. It must not be disposed of in the Park or surrounding areas.
- 4) Loud music, amplified instruments, communication systems are not allowed in the Park.
- 5) Refuse containers in the Parks are to be used only for refuse from activities in the Park. Refuse including yard waste may not be brought into the Parks and deposited.
- 6) No person shall deface, disfigure, break, cut, tamper with or displace or remove any Park District equipment (i.e. tables, benches, fence, etc.)
- 7) No person shall damage, cut, carve, uproot or injure any tree or bark or pick the flowers or seeds of any tree or plant in any Park, nor shall any person attach rope, wire or other contrivances to any tree or plant in the Park. Nor shall any person dig in or otherwise disturb any grass area or in any way injure or impair the beauty or usefulness of any Park.
- 8) Park hours are: See attached copy of Park hours.
- 9) The Mt. Prospect Golf Course is the only Park where golf is allowed.
- 10) Glass containers are not allowed in the Parks.
- 11) Motorized vehicles are not allowed in the Parks.
- 12) Remember our Parks are patrolled and Police enforces ordinances.
- 13) Parking in the Friendship Park Conservatory parking lot is not permitted for the use of Rosemary Argus Friendship Park.
- 14) Parking for Meadows Park is only permitted in the Meadows Park parking lot. Parking in private businesses or residential parking lots is not permitted.
- 15) Cars may not be driven or parked in any grassy area.
- 16) To guarantee the use of picnic tables, there is a \$10 fee per table. Picnic tables are not guaranteed to be in the park if not reserved.
