

Suggested Supply List for Exploring Pastels

- Paper
 - Best paper – Clairfontaine: Ingres pastel pad neutral colors.
 - Good paper – “Canson MiTeintes” paper in gray, cream, or beige, - no white.
- Soft Pastel Chalks
 - Best brands – Rembrandt, Prismacolor.
- Pastel Pencils
 - Best brands - Derwent or Stabillo CarbOthello
- Kneaded eraser
- Compass
- Soft washcloths to wipe your hands.
- Drawing board – foam board is light and easy to carry.
- Half inch art drafting tape to hold your paper in position on the board.
- A paper stump for blending.
- Vinyl gloves
- Pencil sharpener
- Sketchpad 9” by 12”
- Blair Spray fixative matte finish to preserve color and stop smudging.

Bring photographs of what you would like to draw - landscapes, flowers, animals, etc. Your own photos are best.
