

Supply List for Oil Painting Class

Sketch Pad 9 x 12

Pencils

Stretched Canvas or Canvas Panels in assorted sizes. 8x10, 9x12...

Odorless Mineral Spirits

Brushes- a variety of sizes and shapes recommended... rounds, flats, filberts in suggested sizes #2, 6, 9. Make sure they are for "oil painting"

Trowel Shaped Painting Knife- #14 (or thereabout)

Roll of paper towel

Container for Mineral Spirits- a small jar or can (tuna can)

Palette- no smaller than 12x12. This can be Masonite, wood, plastic, or disposable.

Oil Paints- **NO QUICK DRYING OR WATER MISCIBLE.** Grumbacher, Gamblin, or Winsor & Newton are good brands. Most of these will also offer a student/academy line which will be less expensive and will be fine for class.

- Ivory Black (you can easily mix black from the colors below, so feel free to leave this one out)
- Titanium White (Large tube recommended)
- Burnt Sienna
- Raw Umber
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Ultramarine Blue
- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Permanent Rose
- Phthalo Blue
- Sap Green
- Winsor & Newton Liquin (small bottle)

Tackle box or some kind of box to carry all smaller equipment.
