



Mt. Prospect Park District was incorporated in June 1955 and is located approximately 24 miles northwest of Chicago. Encompassing more than 450 acres, the Park District provides recreation programs, facilities and services to portions of Mount Prospect, Arlington Heights, Des Plaines and Elk Grove Village with a combined population of 215,000.

Mt. Prospect Park District offers its residents a total of 32 parks and recreational facilities including, a 4.3 star golf course (Golf Advisor), neighborhood playgrounds, pools, fitness centers, ball diamonds, biking and walking paths.

Mission Statement: To provide exceptional parks and recreational experiences that enrich the quality of life for present and future generations.

Mt. Prospect Park District is headed by an Executive Director who oversees the following divisions: Recreation, Golf Operations, Community Relations and Marketing, Administration, Human Resources and Risk, and Parks and Planning. The Executive Director in turn reports to a seven-member Board of Commissioners who are elected officials serving staggered four-year terms.
